Tuition:

The Capital Development Fee, Participation Deposit, Registration/Re-enrollment Fee and Extended Care Fees are separate from tuition and are paid directly to Casa di Mir. We have contracted with FACTS for the collection of monthly tuition. Over 4,000 schools nationwide use FACTS, including many schools in the bay area.

An initial non-refundable deposit equal to 10% of annual tuition is due directly to Casa di Mir upon enrollment or re-enrollment of the student. There are two options for payment of the tuition balance: payment in full by July 1 or payment over 9 months beginning in July and ending in April. (Payment of the current year's tuition is suspended in March, as the 10% deposit for the following school year is due at that time.) All families choosing the monthly payment plan must enroll in the FACTS Tuition Management program. An annual fee of \$41 will be assessed by FACTS within 14 days of enrollment.

If you choose to budget through FACTS, you will authorize automatic bank payments directly from your bank account for your monthly tuition bill. Please be assured that neither FACTS nor the school will have direct access to or any knowledge about the status of your bank account. It is simply a pre-authorized bank-to-bank transfer of funds.

In addition to the tuition and fees outlined above, all families are encouraged and expected to support our Annual Fund Drive by making a tax-deductible donation to the school.

Limited financial assistance is available, based on need. Please contact the Business Manager if you have questions regarding payment of tuition or fees or if you think you might have a need for financial assistance.
