

You can get 2019-20 Casa events to show on your personal calendar by subscribing to the Casa calendar feed.

Here's how to do it:

1. Place your cursor over the following link:
<https://calendar.google.com/calendar/ical/vtjh4p4pek7q1gddfs6lavdh50%40group.calendar.google.com/public/basic.ics>
2. Right-click, and select "Copy Link Address" in Chrome, or the equivalent command in the browser you are using, to copy the link address to your clipboard.

The next step depends on what calendar application you are using.

For Google Calendar, follow the instructions on [this page](#), in the "Add using a link" section. Paste the URL that you just copied to the clipboard into the URL field.

For Apple Calendars, follow the instructions on [this page](#). Paste the URL that you just copied to the clipboard into the URL field.

For other calendar applications, or if you get stuck, send an email to sgresham@casadimir.org and they'll be happy to try to help.

NOTE: You can also get calendar events onto your calendar by downloading the .ics file and importing it into your calendar application. However, if you do it this way, it is a one-time capture. You won't be notified of any changes to the calendar that occur over the course of the year. If you subscribe to the feed, as explained here, you should only have to do it once and your calendar will always be up to date.
