



What are the likely scenarios for Fall?

- The school will continue to offer both on-site learning for all levels, as well as distance learning for Primary and Elementary students who are not ready to return on campus. The number of students the school can enroll into the distance learning programs will be limited.
- To be able to plan appropriately, it's important for parents to complete the survey to inform the school of their preference for on-site v distance learning. The survey will be sent the week of Feb. 24.
- Once the school has information on the number of students requesting distance learning, we'll be able to share more detailed information.
- Depending on the choices families make for Fall, the current Pods *may* change in composition, as well as the Guide leading the Pod.
- The school will work hard to minimize changes, yet flexibility is needed to ensure the best staffing and successful combinations of students to deliver the strongest programs.
