



Question #4 - What criteria are used to establish our ability to offer Mon.-Fri. on-site programming for students?

Square footage continues to be a key element. The standard we've worked with was to make sure each room was big enough for children to work with 6 ft. between one another, although there are recent official suggestions reducing this distance to 3 ft.

Two unique variables for our Montessori school are that student work tends to take more space than a desk and our students are able to move freely. Thus, we've also analyzed floor space, traffic patterns, and larger individual work stations to ensure ample space between students.

Given vaccination efforts, a healthier local region, and several changes from the CDC, state, and our county, we are currently working with a model that will likely allow us to offer 5 days on-site for all of our classrooms, with potential ½ days once a week.
